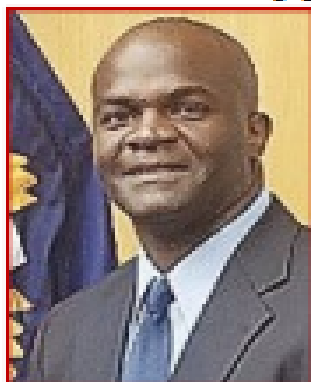

Dear Fellow Floridian,

Six months ago, Hurricane Ian hit Florida's families, bringing utter devastation to Southwest Florida and damage in 51 counties throughout the state. I know so many of you are still working to recover every day, and I'm fighting to get your families and businesses every resource needed to get back on your feet.

I was proud to lead members of the Florida and Puerto Rico delegations in introducing the *Hurricane Tax Relief Act* in March, which would provide disaster-loss tax relief to families in 51 Florida counties and Puerto Rico impacted by Hurricanes Ian, Nicole and Fiona.

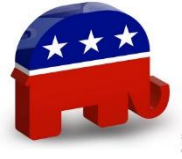
